
State Capitol: Parking Directions

and Bus Routes

for Hawai'i International Forgiveness Day



The address of the State Capitol is 415 S. Beretania Street, Honolulu, HI 96813.

By car, approach the Capitol on Beretania St. (from the east) or on Punchbowl St. (from the north) There are five convenient places to park, shown on the map above. All are free of charge on Sundays.

Recommended parking locations:

1. The State Health Department, at Beretania and Punchbowl, northwest corner; surface lot

2. The Kalanimoku State Building, on Punchbowl just south of Beretania; turn left into underground parking lot

3. Street parking on S. King Street between Richards and Punchbowl (metered; free on Sundays)

4. Street parking on Richards St. between King and Beretania (metered; free on Sundays)

5. Parking lot at 'Iolani Palace, entrance off Richards St.

You may stop briefly in a small round entrance driveway directly in front of the Capitol, to drop off passengers or make deliveries.

It arriving by bus, get off at the main bus shelter on Beretania, in front of the Capitol, between Beretania and Richards.

Bus information:

from Leeward: 52, 40, 42, 43A & E, 62 from Waikiki: 2, 13, 42 from Windward: 55, 56, 57, 57A, 65 off on bishop and hotel, and walk to the capital from Hawaii Kai: 1, 1L off on bertainia, and punchbowl -- walk to capital from Kaimuki: 3, 9 from Aiea: 11 Bus 4 also goes to the Capitol

Enter the Capitol Rotunda on foot: from Beretania side, through the front entrance to the Capitol, or from 'Iolani Palace side, the Queen's entrance to the Capitol

Since this is a partly-sheltered open-air venue, you may want to be prepared with a hat and sunscreen, or with an umbrella.

Healthy drinks and modest snacks will be served throughout the event time, from 1:00 pm. to 5:00 pm.
